- * Pedagogical Content Knowledge (PCK)




Wiki?


What is a Wiki?



* A web site

- * A Content Management System (CMS)
- * Unlike conventional web sites, where a webmaster edits all of the pages, wikis were created to permit collaborative editing of pages.
- * This means that the database retains a record of all changes, and that unwanted edits can be reversed.





Mediawiki




- * The are numerous implementations of the wiki platform.






